The historically diverse Denham Court Mansion, parts of which are more than 700 years old, is also home to the club's Heron Restaurant, which is open to non-members, non-golfers, business parties and families alike.

The kitchen is run by an emerging new talent, James Hatswell, whose worldwide travels while cooking for the Royal Navy have given his food a truly international twist.

The Heron Restaurant is open on Sundays from noon. The dress code is smart/casual. The restaurant has good provision for children and babies, as well as facilities for the disabled

The chef offers a flexible menu for different dietary requirements. Typical costs for a meal are £23.95 for a three-course meal and £17.95 for two courses. Under-12s eat for half price and under fives are free. Mains range from f10-f14.

Afternoon tea is also available at Denham Court Mansion, any day of the week.

The Spike Bar provides simpler meals and specialises in Japanese dishes. It is open daily from 7am to 9pm and is also open for business lunches. It is a more informal setting and prices range from £5 to £14.
